

Goal

To enhance the capacity of countries to collect, disseminate and use reliable statistics and indicators to assess the relative situation of women and men in gendersensitive, policy-relevant areas

Violence against Women

- Establishment of the Fiends of the Chair group on Indicators to measure Violence Against Women (FOC-VAW), 2008 UN Statistical Commission;
- Adoption of minimum set of indicators on VAW, 2009 UN Statistical Commission;
- UN Guidelines for the Production of Statistics on Violence Against Women, 2013

Background



- Internationally-agreed indicators to monitor gender equality and women's empowerment (IAEG-GS 2011 and UN Statistical Commission 2013)
 - Gender indicators (52)
 - Gender indicators related to national norms (11)
- Five domains
 - Economic structures, participation in productive activities and access to resources
 - Education
 - Health and related services
 - Human rights of women and the girl child
 - Public life and decision-making

Organization of indicators in Tiers



Tier I

- Indicators conceptually clear, with an agreed international definition and regularly produced by countries
- → International data compilation

Tier II

- Indicators conceptually clear, with an agreed international definition, but not yet regularly produced by countries
- → Promoting capacity building activities


Tier III

- Indicators for which international standards need still to be developed and not regularly produced by countries
- → Methodological developments e.g., EDGE project

Minimum Set platform




- Improve access to data and methods

- Contribution from 14 partner agencies




Data availability Tier I indicators (35 inds)
