Internship Topic: Undergraduate Women and Pathways to STEM Study and Careers

Internship Description:

Using existing survey data (25 surveys with undergraduate women) and conducting 5 additional surveys with Wellesley students, the intern will produce a research brief and co-write an academic paper on girls' pathways to undergraduate STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) study and careers.

Intern Responsibilities:

The intern will conduct peer interviews, review and summarize data, and work with qualitative data analysis software.
